- 2 Sponsored seats and desks are not fixed in their location within a Reading Room and may be moved.
- 3 Wording will be limited by size of the plaque. Text is to be agreed with the British Library before being installed.
- 4 Adopt a Book is subject to availability. If your preferred book is not available, we will work with you and our curators to find a suitable alternative.
- 5 Naming a seat or desk or adopting a book does not allow you to reserve preferred access to this space or item.
- 6 After making your gift, we will arrange a special visit to see your sponsored desk or seat in situ. Thereafter, you must have a valid Reader Pass or be accompanied by a member of the Development team to enter a Reading Room.

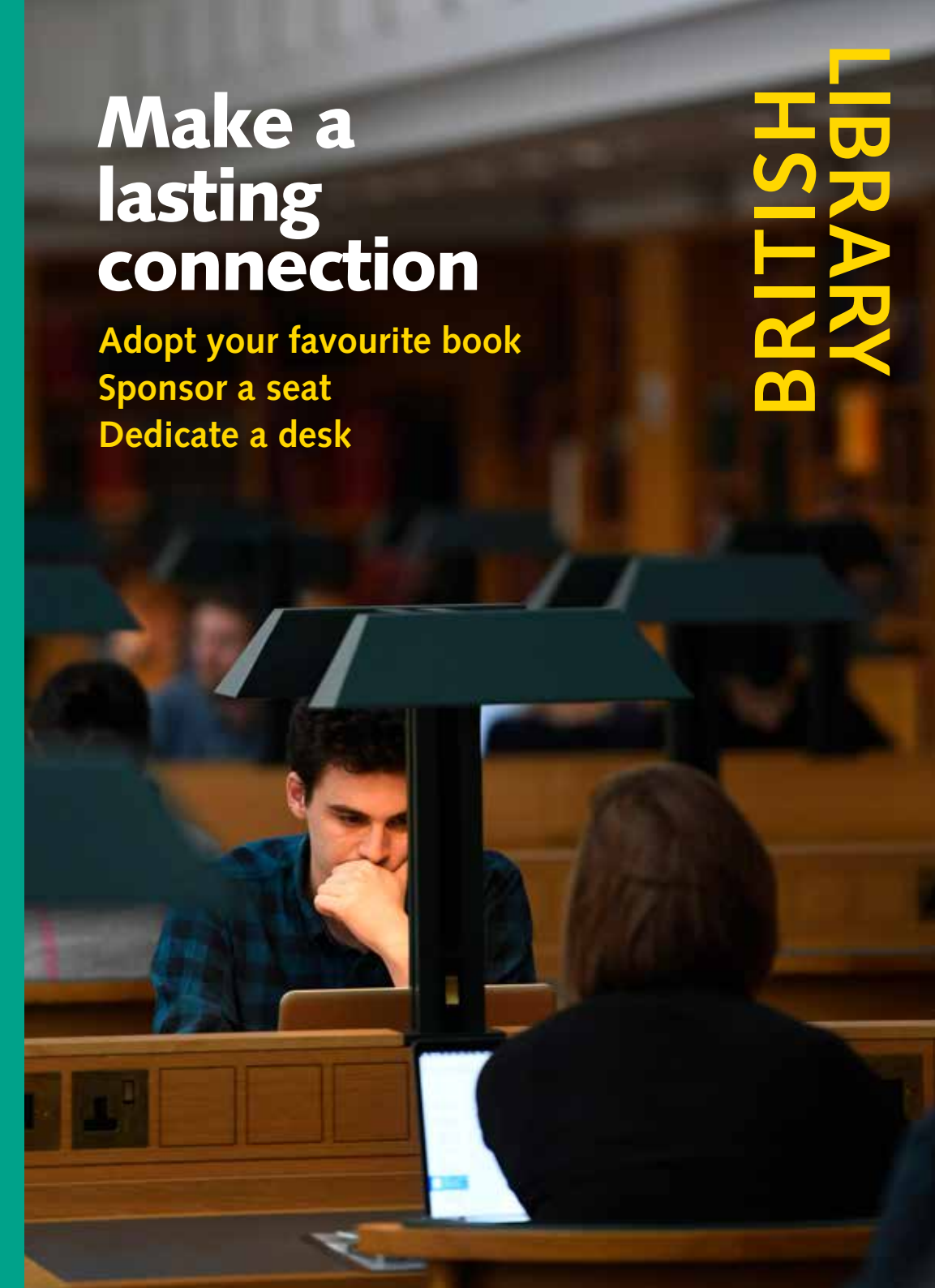
